#### MR. FOUZUL HAMEED: DRIVEN BY VISION, GUIDED BY MISSION

History often shows that institutions rise through the vision and commitment of a single individual devoted to community service. The story of Zahira College is one of collective resolve triumphing over formidable challenges.

Historians describe the four decades under the leadership of the late T. B. Jayah and the late Mr. A. M. A. Azeez as Zahira's "Golden Era", when the College flourished as a centre of Islamic thought and intellectual excellence, distinguished by literary, athletic, and cultural achievements.

Zahira's most challenging period began with the late Azeez's resignation in 1961. Over the next forty-five years, despite changes in leadership, educational standards and discipline steadily declined, eroding public confidence and diminishing enrolment. Yet, as history often proves, renewal follows adversity. That renewal came in the person of Mr. Fouzul Hameed.

Though not an academician, he possessed—like the founder-administrator, the late I. L. M. Abdul Aziz—the rare ability to lead with clarity, determination, and vision. Through his unwavering commitment and remarkable Midas touch, Mr. Fouzul Hameed revived Zahira College, restoring it as the cradle and citadel of Muslim education.

Serving as President of the Old Boys' Association from 2005 to 2013, he led a dedicated team from the OBA and PTA in a focused effort to restore academic excellence and discipline. Since assuming office as Chairman of the Board of Governors in 2006—a role he continues to hold—he has overseen a systematic programme of infrastructure development alongside significant advances in education, sports, and extracurricular activities.

Together with Principal Mr. Trizvy Marikkar, Mr. Fouzul Hameed envisioned a comprehensive revival aimed at positioning Zahira among the island's leading schools. This transformation includes landmark developments such as the Mutuwappa and Al-Maktoom Buildings, the near-completion of the Iqbal Building, the refurbishment of Ghafoor Hall, modern canteens, a fully upgraded library, a Swimming Pool Complex, and a state-of-the-art Sports Complex scheduled for opening on 7 February 2026.

These achievements stand as enduring testimony to nearly three decades of dedicated service—an era-defining contribution to Zahira's illustrious history. Mr. Fouzul Hameed's pursuit of moving Zahira from "good" to "great" has set the institution firmly on course to reclaim the glory of its Golden Era. As Zahira marks its 133-year journey, it is evident that the Founders' vision endures, and an educational renaissance is well underway.

Mr. Fouzul Hameed's visionary zeal has truly restored Zahira to greatness once again. May Almighty Allah, in His boundless grace and mercy, grant him complete Shifa, enduring Aafiyah, and a long, blessed life.



Relief was distributed in three strategic phases to address both urgent and ongoing needs. The first phase empowered

affected old boys by providing 325 essential packs of cleaning materials, enabling them to begin restoring their homes. Subsequently, the second phase delivered 300 packs of vital dry rations to ensure continued aid.

Finally, reaffirming its steadfast commitment to student welfare, the third phase provided 280 students with vouchers for shoes and socks, enabling them to resume their daily routines with dignity, confidence, and practical comfort.

### MF MUHAMMAD SMASHES MATTHEW ABEYSINGHE'S 200M BREASTSTROKE RECORD



Teen prodigy MF Muhammad of Zahira College delivered a stunning performance, slashing three full seconds off the long-standing mark held by double Olympian Matthew Abeysinghe, and smashed the nearly decade-old men’s 200m breaststroke senior national record on the fourth day of the HNB National and Junior National Short Course Swimming Championship at the Isipathana College Swimming Pool in December, 2025.
